Following a fruitful plenary session in presenting and amending seven draft resolutions, six of which were passed, the BBC receives insider information indicating that Microsoft had given their seal of approval to the draft resolution sponsored by the USA, Guatemala and Germany, but had not done the same for that of Chile's. Thus, as all resolutions require two seals of approval from Non-State Actors (NSAs), the resolution sponsored by Chile therefore did not meet the criteria and was not presented. Perhaps coincidentally, Chile asked about the NSAs involved with the draft resolution sponsored by the USA, Guatemala and Germany, and consequently was one of the few member states that voted against the very same draft resolution.
